Welcome to Persäng's community association

Here we have collected tips and advice for you who are temporary visitors to the area. For everyone's well-being, we ask you to consider the following:

Roads

- Maximum speed within the area is 20 km/h.
- Parking is permitted **only** on private property or on visitor parking at the entrance to the area, located opposite to the mailboxes.

Water and sewer

- Except for toilet paper, flush only what has passed through your body. Tops, hair, textiles, paper towels, tampons, pads, etc. risk causing blockages in our pump systems.
- It is not permitted to pour frying oil & fat, chemicals, medicines etc. into the drain, as this can cause blockage in the drain system.

Garbage etc.

Different property owners can have different agreements with Orust municipality. Find out what applies to your property.

- In general, rubbish should be thrown in the respective bins and not elsewhere.
- Paper, plastic, glass, metal are thrown in recycling stations, for example east of Ellös or in Bokenäset.
- Everything else is transported, with the property owner's care, to the recycling center in Månsemyr, which is located between Ellös and Varekil.
- Note that from April 15 until August 15, it is not permitted to throw garden waste at the fire pit nearby to the soccer field.

Pets

- During the period March 1 to August 20, we keep our dogs on a leash.
- For everyone's comfort, **pick up dog poop.**

Neighborhood cooperation

As a visitor, you may be asked why you are in the area, for everyone's safety.

Persäng is located in a fantastic environment directly adjacent to the Gullmarn nature reserve with many pleasant walking paths. We have a playground with a swing and a sandbox, a soccer field, a boules court and a unique access to Strutsholmen with a swimming area and a small jumping tower. There is a ladder on the boat bridge. The water temperature can be found on our website. On the website, it is also possible to book one of our guest boat berth for smaller boats for a maximum of 2 days.

Help us keep order in the area. Report a fault to the property-owner if you see something that is damaged or broken.
